## ***FINE ARTS AT CVCA: CLASS INFORMATION AT A GLANCE***

### **BAND PROGRAM**

#### *Beginning Band (Instrumental Techniques):*

- Beginning Band is a non-performing group open to students in grades 7–11
- Designed for students to learn a band instrument for the first time
- Students are graduated into Concert Band or Symphonic Band as soon as their skill-level permits

#### *Jr. High Concert Band:*

- Open to Jr. High students
- Audition is not required
- A minimum of 1 year previous experience on a band instrument is required

#### *Marching / Symphonic Band:*

- Open to High School students
- Audition is not required
- Students meet as a marching band during football season and as a symphonic band during the remainder of the school year
- Summer Band Camp begins the first Monday in August and meets during the morning hours

#### *Color Guard:*

- Color Guard is open to High School Students and meets as part of the Marching Band (students are scheduled in band class during the school day for the duration of football season and then move to a study hall for the remainder of the school year)
- Audition is required (auditions are held in May of the previous school year)
- Summer Band Camp begins the first Monday in August and meets during the morning hours
- Additional practices take place on Wednesdays after school during football season

### **ORCHESTRA PROGRAM**

#### *CVCA Orchestra:*

- Open to Jr. High and High School students
- Audition is not required
- A minimum of 1 year previous experience on a string instrument is required

### **CHORAL PROGRAM**

#### *Jr. High Choir:*

- Open to Jr. High students
- Audition is not required

#### *Women's Chorale:*

- Open to 8th grade girls by audition and to 9th –12th grade girls without an audition

#### *Gospel Choir:*

- Open to Jr. High and Sr. High students
- Meets during fourth and fifth period lunch

#### *Concert Choir:*

- Open to Sr. High students
- Audition is required

#### *Chamber Singers:*

- Open to Sr. High students
- Audition is required

#### *Show Choir:*

- Open to Sr. High students
- Audition is required
- Meets Wednesday after school



### **HANDBELL PROGRAM**

#### *Jr. High Ringers:*

- Open to Jr. High students
- Previous handbell experience is not required, but students MUST be proficient in reading music in both bass and treble clefs
- Audition is not required to enroll, but may be required during the first week of school based on the number of available positions or to determine group placement

#### *Intermediate Ringers:*

- Open to Sr. High students generally in 9th and 10th grades (select Jr. High students may be considered for this group based on audition results and available positions)
- Audition or director approval is required
- Preference is given to Jr. High Ringers when filling available positions

#### *Royal Ringers:*

- Open to Sr. High students generally in 11th and 12th grades
- Audition or director approval is required
- Preference is given to Intermediate Ringers when filling available positions

### **ART PROGRAM**

#### *Jr. High Art:*

- Open to Jr. High Students
- Jr. High Art is designed to foster and nurture basic artistic skills in a systematic fashion
- No required prerequisite

#### *Art 1, 2, and 3:*

- Open to High School Students
- Art 1, 2, and 3 are designed to foster and nurture artistic skills at more advanced levels
- Art 1 is a prerequisite for Art 2 and Art 2 is a prerequisite for Art 3

#### *3D Art 1 and 2:*

- Open to High School Students
- Students explore different mediums such as glass mosaics, polymer clay, wire, fiber arts, batik, and stained glass
- 3D Art 1 is a prerequisite for 3D Art 2

#### *Graphic Design:*

- Open to High School Students
- Students explore principles of design incorporating hands-on as well as computer software technology
- Students are required to perform duties outside of the classroom

### **THEATER PROGRAM**

#### *Introduction To Theater:*

- Open to High School students
- Topics such as acting, design, directing, theater history, and dramatic literature are explored

#### *The Royal Theater:*

- Open to Jr. High and High School Students
- Rehearsals take place outside of the school day
- Three productions are presented each year: a one act play for Jr. High students, a fall play, and a spring musical
- The fall play and spring musical are open primarily to High School students with limited positions available to a small number of Jr. High students
- Auditions are required for all potential cast members
- Rehearsals for fall productions begin in October with performances in November
- Rehearsals for the spring musical begin in late January with performances in late April and early May
