

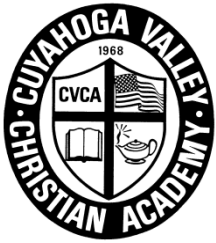

# PACKING LIST FOR DISNEY TOUR

- ✓ **Medication** you will be bringing (should be listed on back of medical info form)
- ✓ **Pillow and Blanket** for bus ride
- ✓ **Snacks** for the bus – remember, **NO DAIRY PRODUCTS!**  
Small coolers are fine
- ✓ **Bible** for devotions
- ✓ **Money** for extra snacks and souvenirs (\$50 - \$100)
- ✓ **Cell Phone** (don't forget cell phone charger!)
- ✓ **Toiletries**
- ✓ **ipod** w/ headphones for the bus, if desired
- ✓ **Misc.** Camera  
Movies for the bus (Mrs. Moore must approve!)
- ✓ **Dress Requirements: (see dress code chart for specific information)**  
*Modesty is the key issue when selecting clothing to take on tour.  
No spaghetti straps, tank tops or short-shorts are permitted  
(this includes the bus!).  
Jeans should follow the same standards as school "jeans days"*
  - No swimsuits are needed for this trip
  - **modest** comfortable clothing for travel
  - **modest**, neat, casual clothing for Disney parks
  - khakis and choir/handbell t-shirts for non-Disney performances
  - Disney Performance attire
    - Concert Choir: choir robes, Black shoes, pants, hose only.  
NO athletic shoes under robes.
    - Chamber Singers: tuxes and dresses
    - Royal Ringers: dress black

# Important Details

## Meal Expenses:

On our departure day, each student will receive an envelope, labeled with their name, containing the following:

\$50 in cash

\$75 Disney gift card

The cash is intended to cover the cost of the following 6 meals:

- Dinner on Monday (en route)
- Breakfast and lunch on Tuesday (en route)
- Lunch on Wednesday (fast food between performances)
- Breakfast and lunch on Saturday (en route)

The Disney card is intended to cover the cost of the following 5 meals:

- Dinner on Tuesday (at Epcot)
- Lunch and Dinner on Thursday (Hollywood Studios)
- Lunch and Dinner on Friday (Magic Kingdom)

*Please discuss budgeting with your student. If you do not feel that this will be adequate funding for your students meals, they will need to bring additional cash. Don't forget extra cash for snacks and souvenirs.*

## Labeling:

Make sure your name is clearly marked on your suitcase, book bag, Bible, pillow, CD player, purse, etc. *Everything* you bring with you should be labeled.

## Check in:

Upon arrival at school on Monday morning:

- Check in luggage on either "Bus 1" or "Bus 2" side of auditorium.
- Tag all luggage, back packs, etc. with plastic ties and leave luggage that will be stored under the bus in the designated area for your bus number.

## Long Bus Ride!

Prepare yourself for sleeping on the long bus ride.

- Wear comfortable YET MODEST clothing. Sweats would be best.
- Bring a pillow and blanket – labeled with your name.
- Your carry-on bag must include basic toiletry items.

PLEASE NOTE that during "quiet hours" guys and girls will be separated on the bus. NO EXCEPTIONS!! Guys will ride in front, girls in the back. Chaperones will sit in the middle.

# **Choir / Royal Ringers Disney 2010**

## **Tour Behavior Guidelines**

1. First and foremost, pray that you will have a positive effect on each other and those we meet on tour.
2. Your conduct reflects on you, CVCA, the group and on Christ. At all times your conduct must be Christ-like.
3. Keep in mind that this is a performance "mission" tour. Each of us needs to have a servant's heart, gentle spirit, and patience with one another **EVEN** when we are feeling exhausted.
4. Girls and guys must socialize in designated public areas in the hotel. At **NO** time is a girl allowed in a guy's room or vice versa! Students may meet in a chaperon room (with a chaperon is present) to worship, pray, or socialize.
5. After room check; students are not permitted to leave their hotel room for any reason unless they are accompanied by an adult chaperon.
6. While on Disney property, students must remain in their group under chaperon supervision. Students should **NEVER** be anywhere in a park by themselves.
7. Clothing **MUST** be modest. Ladies, no tank tops, spaghetti straps or short-shorts. This dress code **INCLUDES** the bus ride. Thanks!
8. Do not wear sleepwear or slippers in the hotel lobby.
9. Tour is a team effort. Please go out of your way for others and do your part for the team as a whole.
10. If you obey these guidelines, it will be a great trip for everyone!
11. Perform well, glorify God and have fun!

Minor scrapes, strains: Basic first aid procedures

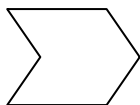
