

Chaperone Packing List

These are the items we've asked the students to pack.

We thought it might be helpful for you to know as you pack for yourself 😊

Bible, pen, pencil

Personal water bottle, marked with name

Sheets, pillow, blanket, and/or sleeping bag

A watch

Bath towel and Beach towel, old shoes or water socks for the river

Toiletries: "Travel-sized" shampoo, soap, toothbrush and toothpaste

Sunscreen, and mosquito repellent with Deet

Modest shorts and shirts, appropriate for the experience.

Jeans, sweatshirt and/or jacket for cool evenings or rainy weather.

Rain poncho, if desired.

Swim suits: Girls need a one-piece suit and cover up to wear when going back and forth to the pool

Flip-flops for shower, and tennis shoes for all activities. (No sandals)

Flashlight

Small backpack or "daybag" for keeping belongings together on the bus

A few extra dollars for the snack shop (Dollar bills are better than \$5's or \$10's.)
