## Ideas

### Poems:

**Shape poem**—make it in the shape of an ark

Acrostic: Use a word like “Rescue” or a Phrase, like “Noah was Obedient” and create each line of a poem.

**Storyboard:** Draw, computer generate, or clip pictures from magazines to illustrate a large board divided into sections like a comic.

**News article:** Create an article after you “interview” Noah and his family

**Comic strip:** Draw frames of a comic strip to tell the story

**Diary:** Be a member of Noah’s family and write a “diary” **Short Story** Make up a story about something that occurred on the ark.

**Poster:** Create a poster illustrating Gen 6.

**Dramatization:** Write a play or screen play.
