Government

Basis of Government

God is supreme ruler controlling nations and rulers.

Human government was established by God to control sinful man.

The powers that be are ordained by God.

Civil authorities are a deterrent to evil, not to good.

The basis of good government and political stability is personal integrity and strong family life.

The actions of believers, even few in number, can change the direction of government.

Nations, Governments, and God

God holds nations responsible for their actions. When men refuse God's rule, he lets them rule themselves.

When a godly city or nation turns from God, her sins are often more serious than those of the heathen and her condemnation is greater.

God has often used war to accomplish His purposes.

God at times has had a specific hand in warfare, giving directions, insuring victory, causing others to recognize him.

Personal Citizenship Responsibilities of Believers

Government officials are to be respected for their position and obeyed.

God expects submission to God ordained leaders and condemns rebellion and rioting.

Obedience to God comes before obedience to men when the two conflict.

Love of country and concern for her welfare are natural and are encouraged by example and exhortation.

Believers are responsible to pay their share for the support of government.

Believers must pray for their leaders in order that there may be peaceful living.

Leadership / Administration

Leaders/Leadership

- Good leadership is of extreme importance to the welfare of any people
- Leaders should be chosen on the basis of qualifications.
- Leadership responsibility carries with it high demands in personal living, often higher than is expected of others.
- Leaders must be concerned for the unity of God's people.
- Leaders must be faithful in carrying out responsibilities and keeping promises.
- Godly leaders place God's honor above their own.
- True leadership is servanthood, not lordship.
- God must be recognized as the one who promotes and gives victories.
- An effective leader is concerned about an orderly transfer of leadership when his term is completed.

- Even in corrupt times, it is possible to serve God faithfully.

Inconsistency in a leader confuses his followers and causes loss of respect.

Administrative principles

- Responsibility should be distributed in order that work is done effectively.
- Individual gifts should be recognized in the delineation of responsibilities: each person should concentrate on specific areas of work.
- Delegation of responsibility must include delegation of authority to act within set limits.
- Job descriptions should be clearly delineated.
- Unity within an organization and appreciation for one another are essential to the stability of a group.
- Various segments of a group should be fairly represented to lessen the danger of partiality.
- Adequate preparation should precede a major change.
- Projects should be completed in an orderly fashion.
- Provision must be made for irregularities, human error and sin.
- Decision by lot has Scriptural precedent and done in recognition of God's sovereignty can indicate God's will.
- Gifts to those in office endanger justice and are therefore not to be received.
