## Websites

1. [www.intute.ac.uk](http://www.intute.ac.uk) choose Arts/Humanities and scroll down to choose American literature. Type in your author name. Your results will list an annotated list of sites to continue searching. Look at the annotations—they tell you if the site is good/bad as well as what they pertain to—biographical etc.
2. [www.ipl.org](http://www.ipl.org) go to literary criticism by letter of author's name, click on his/her name link Read the annotations to see which links are appropriate.
3. [www.altavista.com](http://www.altavista.com) After skipping the first several commercial sites, read the annotations to zero in on biography, criticism, etc.
4. <http://www.literaryhistory.com> This is a list of links to articles on your author of choice.
5. <http://www.enotes.com> type in your author's name and receive a list of articles about him/her.
6. <http://www.todayinliterature.com> This is a sponsored site, so you will be asked to pay for extra pages. But, the initial blog given is informative and gives ideas for paths to investigate.
7. <http://www.uncp.edu> this is a college web page that connects to a syndicated search. Scroll to the bottom of the home page and type your author name into the search bar.
8. [www.infohio.org](http://www.infohio.org) Go to the 9-12 button —>Ebsco validate User name: think password: infohio choose biographies and type in your author name to visit lots of links.
9. [www.infohio.org](http://www.infohio.org) Go to ebsco student research center on left, choose English Lang arts Literary criticism, then type in your author/poet's name in the search bar. Copy citation information into a word doc or you will lose it!
