## Re-Register Your Students

All students were mailed re-registration packets on January 21. If you have not already done so, please log onto ParentsWeb, click on the re-enroll link, and re-register your students for next year. All returning students must re-register **no later than MARCH 15** to hold their position in the student body. After March 15, any remaining openings may be filled with new applicants and re-enrollment of returning students can no longer be guaranteed. (This is particularly critical for our current 9th and 10th grade classes). Please be prepared to pay your re-registration fee online when you re-register. Your student's re-registration fee will increase if you wait to re-register. Re-Registration fees are as follows:

- \$125 if submitted **before** March 15, 2011 at 3:00 p.m.
- \$225 if submitted **between** March 15 at 3:00 p.m. and May 15 at 2011 at 3:00 p.m.
- \$350 if submitted **between** May 15 at 3:00 p.m. and July 15 at 3:00 p.m.

## Applying for Admission

If you have a son or daughter who will be applying for admission to CVCA, we recommend that you call the Admissions Office to register that student for an entrance exam and submit an on-line application as soon as possible (we anticipate having a waiting list in some grades). Log onto CVCA's website, [www.cvcaroyals.org](http://www.cvcaroyals.org). Click on the Admissions tab, select "Application Process" from the drop-down list and follow the prompts from there. The new student application fee is \$70.00. Questions? Call Mrs. Mindy Fullerton, Director of Admissions, at 330-929-0575, ext. 216. Students who are offered admission are required to confirm their enrollment with an enrollment deposit on the following schedule:

- \$125 if submitted **before** March 15, 2011 at 3:00 p.m.
- \$225 if submitted **between** March 15 at 3:00 p.m. and May 15 at 2011 at 3:00 p.m.
- \$350 if submitted **between** May 15 at 3:00 p.m. and July 15 at 3:00 p.m.

You will note on our 2010-11 calendar that Monday, April 25 is the first make-up date that we had scheduled. Please mark your calendar appropriately. **April 25 is now a school day!**

Many of you may have heard that there is legislation pending in the Ohio House (HB 36) and Senate (SB 18) to extend the number of calamity days in 2010-11 from three to five. As of this writing neither of these bills have become law. If anything changes, we will notify you.

## Adjusted Schedule and Delayed Start MARCH 14, 15, 16, 17, 18

- **Students in Grades 8 and 10 begin testing at 8:05 a.m.**
- **Delayed Start for Grades 7, 9, 11, 12 at 10:00 a.m.**

As a state-chartered, nonpublic school, CVCA is required to give the Ohio Graduation Test to all tenth-grade students. Students must pass all five sections of the test to receive a graduation diploma. Students first take the test in the spring of their tenth-grade year. This year's test is scheduled for March 14-18. The five sections of the test are administered one section per day of that week. To administer the test in a way which is least disruptive to the daily school schedule on those days, school will begin for students not being tested at 10:00 a.m.

Students in grade eight will take the Stanford Achievement Test at the same time that tenth-grade students take the Ohio Graduation Test (8:05 a.m.).

All 8th and 10th grade students should report to their assigned testing rooms by 8:05 a.m. on those days. Students in grades 7, 9, 11, & 12 are to be in their homerooms at 10:00 a.m. The cafeteria and library will be opened and supervised as usual for students who must report to school before the adjusted start time.

## ACT and SAT Registration

For juniors interested in taking the ACT or SAT, please see the remaining test dates and registration deadlines below. Students can register for the ACT at [www.act.org](http://www.act.org) and the SAT at [www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com).

When students register, they should input the CVCA school code, 361771. By doing this, CVCA will also receive a copy of the test results and can add this information to the students' test records, which will be sent to colleges along with high school transcripts when students begin the college application process.

### ACT Test Dates:

- April 9, 2011 (*registration deadline of March 4, 2011*)
- June 11, 2011 (*registration deadline of May 6, 2011*)

### SAT Test Dates:

- March 12, 2011 (*registration deadline of February 11, 2011*)
- May 7, 2011 (*registration deadline of April 8, 2011*)
- June 4, 2011 (*registration deadline of May 6, 2011*)

In the fall and winter, CVCA offers prep classes designed to help students do their best on the SAT and ACT tests.

## Advice From Recent Alum

Alex Mosteller '10, a freshman member of the golf team at Covenant College in Chattanooga, TN, was recently contacted by the Alumni Office and asked, **"If you could give advice to a freshman in high school, what would you tell them?"** His advice was very insightful...

"I would tell a high school freshman to **develop good study habits** in high school, because having good study habits in college is essential. You are not in class as much in college, and knowing how to study well is very important in college."

He also shared one of his most important high school experiences that he's depended in college. **"I constantly keep in mind the things I learned on the DR mission trip** – doing daily devotions, saved once/surrender daily, asking for the Holy Spirit to fill me daily – and feel that these have helped me to remain strong in my faith."

## Why You want to Adopt an Exchange Student

In 1989, the Danielsen Christian School in Bergen, Norway sought out CVCA to send some of their best students for a one-year intensive language training program in a Christian environment. Since then, many CVCA host families have developed life-long relationships with their adopted Norwegian students and have fallen in love with this beautiful country and its people.

"The first few weeks were like having a guest in our house. But before we knew it, Jon was a member of our family," former host-mom Jan Iannetta said. Years later, the Iannettas traveled to Norway for their host-son's wedding. "He's a doctor and daddy now," Jan said, proudly displaying a picture of Jon's two girls.

Many CVCA families have had their lives enriched by similar hosting experiences. These students bring to CVCA a richness of culture that enhances the learning experience of everyone. We have

expanded our international student outreach to other nations, notably Brazil, Korea, Germany, and others.

We will soon designate host families for several Danielsen students who are applying to CVCA next year.
