## Come celebrate with us! Groundbreaking Ceremony – June 5, 2011

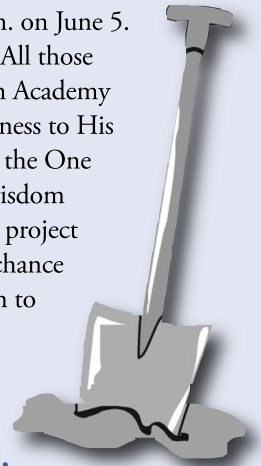

## STUDENT PARKING

### 2011-12 Student Parking Procedures

Student drivers must be registered and display a parking tag visibly in their car prior to parking on campus beginning on the first day of classes, August 16, 2011.

Steps for registering and obtaining a parking space and parking tag are:

1. Pick up an information sheet and registration card at the Welcome Center or Academic Office, or download from the CVCA website.
2. Turn in or mail a copy of a driver's license, car insurance card, and completed registration form to the Academic Office.

Please note: the parking registration form gives students an opportunity to designate a lot preference. The preferred locations will be assigned by the order in which the completed registration form and required copies (driver's license and insurance company card) are turned in to the office. Preferences will be processed and assigned according to class: seniors first, followed by juniors and sophomores.

Assigned parking tags may be picked up in the office during the month of August upon payment of the \$55 parking fee.

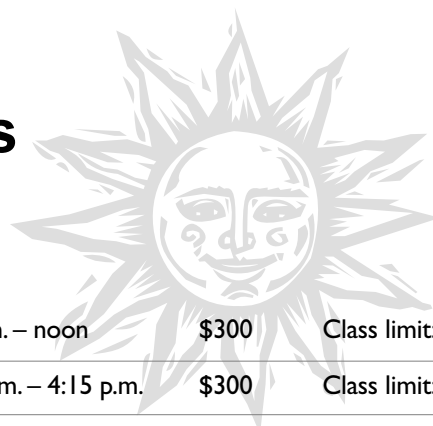

### Attention 7th and 8th Grade Families:

On Thursday, March 24, the Junior High Speech Team did their school proud. We entered six categories of competition at the ACSI regional speech meet at Lake Center Christian School in Hartville and won in four of those six!

Junior high speech began at the end of January when the team members spent a week or two deciding what they wanted to do for their speeches. After some conversations and a little give-and-take, we were set. Then came the practices before school, after school, and 4th period in the library. Sometimes during 7th period I would get a student or two out of study hall and we would practice outside the doors to the Welcome Center. One day the office staff complimented **Cole Bierce**, who could clearly be heard through the glass windows crying out... "Give me liberty or give me death!" Cole ended up winning the best in his category of **Costumed Dramatic Monologue!**

If you enjoy a good **Humorous Poem** now and then, you have no idea what "cute" is until you hear **Maddie Meszaros** doing Shel Silverstein's "One Inch Tall." It's guaranteed to make you smile and remind you of what it's like to be a kid again. Maddie was positively charming. Speaking of Shel Silverstein, **Michaela Miller** did another poem of his, "The Unicorn." If you want to know what happened to this amazing creature who seems to have missed a boat somewhere, just ask Michaela – she'll tell you. In another humorous poem, **Marie Sidle** took us to Middle Earth in a selection from J.R.R. Tolkien's *Fellowship of the Ring*. Marie chose to do Frodo's speech when he was trying to deflect attention away from two friends who were getting dangerously close to revealing his identity. In the category of **Original Speech**, **Lauryn Solomon** and **Hope Bolinger** positively shined like stars. Lauryn made up a three-page poem based on the life of Jesus. "So to sum this poem up, /if you didn't understand, /Jesus preached the Word, /and He spread it to all men." Hope recited a poem she wrote called,

And so did India, who won Best in Category.

On the day of the tournament, we met in one of the library conference rooms for last-minute instructions and a true "pep" talk from one of last year's "speechies," **Maddie Cuckow**. Maddie, who as a freshman went to a state speech tournament this year, was exactly what the team needed. She made us laugh, encouraged us, told us what to watch out for, and even performed a bit of one of her speeches for us. Then, quoting from the best true story ever written, Maddie put us all at ease: "I can do all things through Christ."

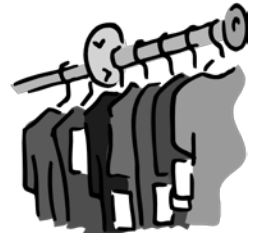
