- Ability to defuse and manage conflict coupled with strong communication skills
- Willingness to maintain CVCA standards of conduct and administer biblical discipline while displaying the ability to relationally connect with students
- Passionate, caring, and pastoral heart toward students who are struggling with personal crisis
- Has the capacity to execute and get things done
- Hard working, team player, who is committed to building a successful Christ-honoring school

Degree(s) and Certification

- Graduate Degree (Note: While an administrator with a degree(s) in education, leadership, or administration is desired, candidates with a different academic background are encouraged to apply.)
- ACSI certification or ability to obtain ACSI administrative certification
