<p>TOPS <i>Monday through Friday</i> Tops may be purchased through Kids Kloset, Young's, Ritchies, Squad-locker, or BSN. Some items offered at these locations may not be approved for everyday uniform wear.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CVCA Polos (long or short-sleeved) • CVCA Quarter-zips • CVCA Long-sleeved team/club T-shirts • CVCA Hoodies • CVCA Sweatshirts • CVCA Letterman Jackets 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All tops must be solid black, royal blue, or gray, except for white hoodies/sweatshirts. An approved CVCA logo must be visible on the front of the shirt. NO SHORT-SLEEVE T-SHIRTS MONDAY-WEDNESDAY. • Polos and quarter-zips (black, royal blue, gray, NO white) • May wear a solid color (white, royal blue, black, or gray) crew neck shirt (short/long-sleeved) under a polo or quarter-zip • May wear CVCA team or club-issued long-sleeved T-shirts (black, royal blue, or gray only, NO white) with prior SAS approval – Must have in-code tops underneath if outer layer is removed. • Long-sleeved hoodies/sweatshirts/full-zip (black, royal blue, gray, white) – Must have in-code tops underneath if outer layer is removed. • Must wear in-code top under letterman jacket • No other outerwear may be worn during the school day
<p>HIGH SCHOOL HOUSE and MIDDLE SCHOOL GRADE LEVEL SPIRIT WEAR <i>Thursdays ONLY</i></p>	<p>HS House/MS School Grade-level T-shirts (long or short-sleeved)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High School House/Middle School Grade-level T-shirts (long or short-sleeved) may be worn on Thursdays. • <i>Students not wearing house or grade-level shirts must wear regular Monday-Wednesday SAS apparel.</i> • May wear a solid long-sleeved shirt underneath a House/Class T-shirt • NO patterns, letters, words, stripes, or thermal underwear
<p>CVCA SPIRIT WEAR <i>Fridays ONLY</i></p>	<p>CVCA Spirit Wear T-shirts (short-sleeved)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any CVCA Spirit Wear is permitted on Fridays only • Includes T-shirts, long-sleeved T-shirts, and sweatshirts • Any colors/patterns approved through CVCA clubs, houses, and grade levels are permitted • May wear a solid long-sleeved shirt underneath a CVCA Spirit Wear T-shirt • NO patterns, letters, words, stripes, or thermal underwear
<p>PANTS</p>	<p>Docker, Jogger, Cargo, Khaki Style</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non-athletic full-length pants. • Solid color tan, khaki, or black ONLY (NO gray) • No sweatpants, leggings, yoga pants, or tights • Shorts are not permitted • Modest and appropriate fit for school culture
<p>SHOES</p>	<p>Closed-toe Shoes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes must be clean and in good repair • Socks must be worn • Shoes must have soles • No sandals/slides, Crocs, slippers, rain boots, five-fingers, or vented water shoes
<p>SOCKS</p>	<p>Required</p>	<p>Any style/color that maintains a respectful design is appropriate (i.e., footie, crew, knee-length)</p>
<p>BELTS</p>	<p>Encouraged but not required</p>	<p>Solid color: black, brown, gray, or white</p>
<p>HAIR</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Neat and well-groomed • Natural color 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please contact the Main Office BEFORE getting a questionable hairstyle or a change in color. • Hair must be styled so that eyes are NOT covered (Students may be asked to pull hair back) • No extreme hairstyles (i.e., shaved portions, spikes, etc.) • No unnatural colors (i.e., blue, pink, green, etc.) • Facial hair is permitted as long as it is neatly trimmed and well-groomed
<p>MEN ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May wear a reasonable amount of business-attire jewelry – includes small earrings (should not be excessive) • Tattoos should not be visible at any time • May NOT wear make-up, including nail polish • Hats and hoods are NOT to be worn in the building at any time • Bandannas and scarves are NOT to be worn during school hours • Pant and shirt chains are not permitted • No blankets • Clothing should not be ripped, cut, or modified in any way. (example: removing the neckline of a sweatshirt) 	
<p>LADIES ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May wear a reasonable amount of business-attire jewelry – includes small nose piercings (should not be excessive) • Tattoos should not be visible at any time • Make-up should be modest and not draw unnecessary attention • Hair accessories must be school-appropriate – no tinsel • Hats and hoods are NOT to be worn in the building at any time • Bandannas and scarves are NOT to be worn during school hours • Pant and shirt chains are not permitted • No blankets • Clothing should not be ripped, cut, or modified in any way. (example: removing the neckline of a sweatshirt) • No midriff or cleavage showing (wear undershirts when appropriate) 	

Enforcement of Student Appearance Standards (SAS)

First Office Referral: Warning

1. An email is sent to parents informing them of the nature of the SAS infraction and that a second infraction will result in two lunch detentions.
2. Documentation of the violation is recorded in Facts SIS (formerly RenWeb).

NOTE: If a student is unable to correct the violation, they may be asked to remain in the Office until it can be corrected.

Second Office Referral:

1. An email is sent to parents informing them of the nature of the SAS infraction and that a third infraction will result in an extended office detention.
2. The student receives two lunch detentions.
3. Documentation of the violation is recorded in Facts SIS (formerly RenWeb).

NOTE: If a student is unable to correct the violation, they may be asked to remain in the Office until it can be corrected.

Third Office Referral and Beyond:

1. An email is sent to parents informing them of the nature of the SAS infraction and that any subsequent infraction will result in an extended office detention.
2. The student receives an extended office detention, with the potential loss of PRT.
3. Documentation of the violation is recorded in Facts SIS (formerly RenWeb).

NOTE: If a student is unable to correct the violation, they may be asked to remain in the Office until it can be corrected.
