CVCA students are offered a wide range of co-curricular groups, activities, and events to pursue throughout middle school and high school. Social, academic, scientific, creative, athletic...whatever a student's interests, there is a place for them to get involved.

In addition to more involved clubs and committees, student-focused events occur throughout the year, including Homecoming, Spirit Week, House events, Junior/Senior prom, and more.

Academic Challenge: A high school and middle school "quiz bowl" competition between schools on a variety of academic topics. Weekly practice is held during lunch and/or after school.

Art Club: Students enjoy drawing, painting, crafting, and more once a week after school.

Brotherhood (Seniors Only): Study God's Word together and encourage one another in our walk with Christ.

Diakonos (Service Club): "Diakonos" is Greek for "servant." Students gather for fellowship and encouragement to engage in Christ-motivated ministry close to home. Students serve in housing ministries in Akron or with the paper recycling at CVCA. Each year, Diakonos students and adults serve during spring break with ministries throughout Summit and neighboring counties. Meets with the Embrace Club during lunch once a week.

LeadHer Circle (Girls' Bible Study): A community for high school girls interested in business and leadership, offering biblical discussion, mentorship, and leadership development.

Nail Polish Club: A time for middle school girls to relax after the school week for fellowship and to paint their nails. Twice per month, after school.

Ping Pong Club: Enjoy a game of ping pong each day during 8th period study hall.

Racing Club: Learn mechanics, problem-solving, and motorsports engineering by maintaining gas and electric karts. Gain hands-on experience competing in Purdue University's EV racing competitions.

Robotics Team: Design and build robots using CAD while developing product marketing, technical writing, and

engineering documentation. Present an interactive exhibit showcasing the full engineering design process.

Royal Fools Improv Theater Club: Practice each week after school and perform several times per year.

Royal Vision Show Choir: Rehearse once per week after school. Audition required for high school. No auditions for middle school.

Ski Club: Students meet once per week after school at Brandywine Ski Resort.

Talking Royals Speech and Debate Team: Travels to area schools to compete throughout the winter season. The high school team practices 2-3 times a week after school and competes in 10-12 Saturday tournaments. The middle school team practices twice a week after school and competes in 5-8 Saturday tournaments.

Ultimate Frisbee Club: Twice a week after school, fall and spring.

Yearbook: Students create all aspects of the CVCA Yearbook.
