

## 7th Grade Supply List 2017-2018

To assist junior high students with organizational skills, teachers have been very intentional in indicating certain colors and sizes of binders, as well as other materials. Individual teachers may request additional class supplies.

*Student planners will be provided for each 7th grade student*

- 2 large paper book covers
- 1 pack of highlighters (any colors)
