

# Student Appearance Standards for Young Men

Items not listed in Standards are not permitted

ITEM	STYLE	DESCRIPTION
<b>POLO SHIRTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Long-sleeved or short-sleeved polos: must be purchased through Kids Kloset or BSN</li> </ul>	Black, white, and royal, displaying CVCA monogram (Kids Kloset) White polos <u>must</u> be worn with a black, white or gray crew-neck T-shirt Nike black, blue, grey from BSN displaying CVCA monogram
<b>DRESS SHIRTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Long-sleeved or short-sleeved</li> </ul>	White or light blue dress shirts Free of name-brand logos or lettering Top shirt button may be unbuttoned, but collar buttons must be buttoned, shirt must be tucked in neatly with belt visible
<b>T-SHIRTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Long-sleeved or short-sleeved crew neck</li> </ul>	Cotton or cotton/poly blend: Solid black, gray, or white; no print should be visible through the outer shirt No thermal underwear
<b>TURTLENECKS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Long-sleeved mock or fold-over style</li> </ul>	Black or white cotton or cotton/poly blend Worn under dress shirts or polos No sweaters or thermal underwear
<b>SLACKS/SHORTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Uniform style</li> <li>No crop or capri length</li> <li>Walking-length shorts</li> <li>No jeans</li> </ul>	Uniform style as follows: Tan-khaki (all cotton or cotton/poly blend); Pleated or flat front; Slit or welt pockets No rivets or carpenter loops; must not be ripped, split or frayed Must adhere to business-attire standards for proper fit, and must avoid noticeable low rise Shorts should maintain the look of the longer style shorts not calf length Worn with a business-attire belt; solid black, solid brown, solid gray or solid white
<b>VEST/SWEATER</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Monogrammed V-neck</li> <li>Two pocket cardigan</li> </ul>	Black; monogrammed and available through Kids Kloset only Must be worn over a uniform dress shirt or polo
<b>OUTERWEAR</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Two monogrammed styles - recommended for cold weather comfort in school</li> </ul>	Black; monogrammed full zip and ¼ zip, available through Kids Kloset Nike ¼ CVCA monogrammed, available through BSN CVCA issued sports ¼ zip may also be worn <u>Must be worn over a uniform dress shirt, polo or spirit wear t-shirt</u> Recommended for cold weather comfort; <i>CVCA Sweatshirts are Spirit Wear Days Only</i>
<b>SHOES/BOOTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must have a closed toe</li> </ul>	Any reasonable shoe material except Croc style plastic; clean and in good repair Shoelaces must be tied. No sandals, slippers, mules, clogs, rain boots, five-fingers, or vented water shoes Check with the office if you have questions
<b>SOCKS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Required when worn with sports-specific shoes</li> </ul>	Any style or color sock that maintains a respectful design is appropriate (i.e., footie, crew, knee length)
<b>BELTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be worn at all times on pants with belt loops</li> </ul>	Business-attire Solid black, solid brown, solid gray or solid white
<b>TIES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Long or bow ties</li> </ul>	Any respectful design
<b>Chapel Attire</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Standard dress code as described above for Monday through Wednesday; dress shirt with a tie is encouraged but optional</li> </ul>	
<b>Spirit Fridays</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Uniform slacks or shorts with a CVCA sweatshirt (purchased from the CVCA Booster Club) or an approved CVCA club, group, or team shirt with CVCA monogram or crest. No letter jackets. Wearing a colorful crew-neck t-shirt under Spirit wear is permitted. CVCA issued sweatshirts and hoodies are only permitted to be worn on Spirit wear days.</li> </ul>	
<b>Accessories</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Young men may wear a reasonable amount of business-attire jewelry (no earrings)</li> <li>All students are to keep their hair neat and well-groomed. Extreme hairstyles and unnatural hair color (blue, green, etc.) are not acceptable. Some examples would be hair with shaved portions or spikes. Hair may not cover either or both eyes or completely cover the ears. Young men: hair may be kept pulled back to accomplish this purpose, but while at school all hair should be above the collar completely. Boys are allowed to have facial hair, but it must be trimmed neatly and well-groomed. Bandanas and scarves are not to be worn during school hours.</li> <li>Visible pierced body parts are not in code for young men. Male students are not permitted to wear earrings during the school day or formal school events. (Including field trips, homecoming and prom). Tattoos are not to be visible at any time.</li> <li>Remember also that beyond school hours, the PRINCIPLE of MODESTY is always in effect for all CVCA events on or off campus. Anything which draws attention to oneself serves more to distract from this principle rather than to promote it.</li> </ul>
