Parental cooperation is needed. **Ladies:** Dresses with the following characteristics **do not** meet the modesty standard:

- Excessively tight/clingy material
- Backless dresses
- Low cut dresses, cleavage showing
- Hemline or slit more than 3 inches higher than the top of knee
- Midriff showing (2 piece dresses, mesh, cut-outs)

**Gentlemen:** Attire for this event is suit and tie OR dress pants, dress shirt, and tie.

Male students and guests are not permitted to wear earrings to this CVCA sponsored event.
