

College Level (CL) Dual Credit Classes in 2021-2022 School Year

Through a partnership with Malone University, CVCA offers the option of dual credit (receive both high school and college credit) in grades 11 and 12 for the following courses:

- CL Human Anatomy & Physiology 1 and 2 (only for students in Medical Professions SOD) (8 credits, 4 each semester)
- CL Intro. to Statistics and Probability (3 credits)
- CL English Composition and CL Literature in Society (6 credits, 3 each semester)
- CL Pre-Calculus (4 credits)
- CL World History 2 (3 credits)
- CL Apologetics (Honors Bible 12) (3 credits)

Procedures to take CL Dual Credit Classes

Students who would like the option for CL Dual Credit must take the following required steps to complete their enrollment with Malone University for the 2021-2022 school year.



Application Deadlines

- Students who plan to apply for state funding must apply to Malone by **March 12, 2021**. Otherwise the admissions application deadline is **May 31, 2021**.
- Students who have already taken a CL dual credit class the previous year do NOT need to re-apply to Malone. They are already in the program. However, to receive funding from the State, you WILL need to re-apply for state funding for 2021-2022.



Complete Online Application

1. Visit: malone.edu/admissions-aid/apply
2. Select: **Application** (first box under Malone University application)
3. New users select **Sign Up** (link in bottom right) and follow the prompts
4. Existing users **Login**
5. Under **Student Type**, answer all the questions listed
6. Choose your **Program**, select your major, if yours is not listed choose "undecided"
7. Choose **Fall Semester 2021**
8. Complete each subsection – including personal information, academic information (you will need your CVCA GPA), test information (not necessary or required at this time), application information, and relationship information
9. **Submit** the application



Submit High School Transcript

The CVCA Guidance Office will submit your transcript to Malone University for you.



Application is Reviewed

Once your online application is complete, Malone University will review it. Students who qualify will receive an acceptance letter from Malone.
