

# 2023-2024 CLUBS & EXTRA-CURRICULARS

CVCA students are offered a wide range of co-curricular groups, activities, and events to pursue throughout middle school and high school. Social, academic, scientific, creative, athletic...whatever a student's interests, there is a place for them to get involved.

In addition to more involved clubs and committees, student-focused events occur throughout the year, including Homecoming, Spirit Week, House events, Junior/Senior prom, and more.

Academic Challenge: A HS and MS "quiz bowl" competition between schools on a variety of academic topics. Practice after school and during lunch. Advisors: Mr. McSparran-Varsity, Mrs. Riordan–MS, Both–JV

**Art Club:** Students enjoy drawing, painting, crafting, and more once a week after school. Advisors: Ms. Foti and Ms. McSparran

Boys Basketball Club: An intramural opportunity for young men who like to play basketball but are not on the varsity team. Play once a week. Advisor: Mr. Peters

Diakonos (Service Club): "Diakonos" is Greek for "servant." Students gather for fellowship and encouragement to engage in Christ-motivated ministry close to home. Students serve in housing ministries in Akron or with the paper recycling at CVCA. Each year, Diakonos students and adults serve during spring break with ministries throughout Summit and neighboring counties. Meets with the Embrace Club during lunch once a week. Advisor: Mr. McSparran

History Club: Students engage in immersive computer-based historical simulations (like Civilization VI) each week after school. Advisor: Mr. McSparran

Nail Polish Club: A time for MS girls to relax after the school week for fellowship and to paint their nails. Twice per month, after school. Advisor: Miss Jones

Ping Pong Club: During 8th period study hall. Advisor: Mr. Ramey

Puzzle Club: For 6th graders (may extend to grades 7 and 8). Students enjoy jigsaw puzzles and brainteaser puzzles. Twice per month, after school. Advisor: Mrs. Shelford

Practice each week after school and perform several times per year. Advisor: Mr. Riordan

Royal Vision Show Choir: Rehearse once per week after school. Audition required for HS. No auditions for MS. Advisor: Mrs. Moore
