

# Jterm 2026 Trip Offerings

Welcome to January Term 2026!

Our January term sessions increase opportunities for learning and exploration that challenge our students in areas of interest and encourage deeper faculty-student relationships through enrichment electives, educational travel, service, mission trips, and Career Experience Opportunities (CEO). Jterm is January 5-9, 2026.

The Middle School Jterm program is designed to cultivate spiritual, educational, and personal growth in each student while increasing student and family choice in the upper middle school grades.

#### 6th Grade:

Sixth-grade students will participate in a variety of experiential activities and field trips throughout Jterm week. No sign-ups are required for this grade level.

#### 7th and 8th grade:

Students in 7th and 8th grade are required to enroll in **one** of the following options:

- All-day class
- Morning (AM) and afternoon (PM) class sessions
- Overnight trip experience

#### **High School:**

Jterm is a CVCA graduation requirement. High school students must enroll in **one** of the following options:

- All-day class
- Morning (AM) and afternoon (PM) class sessions
- Domestic or International Trip
- Career Experience Opportunity

**Winter Athletes and Trips:** Winter **athletes** are expected to select a local Jterm opportunity, unless their team is participating in a specific Jterm-related experience, so they can participate in practices and games as outlined in the Student/Parent Handbook. Any questions or concerns regarding this policy should be directed to the athletic department.

- To allow for a more enriching travel experience, international trips may extend into Christmas break.
- A non-refundable deposit is required at the time of registration. CVCA reserves the right to cancel any trip
  that does not meet the minimum number of participants. In the event of a cancellation, deposits may be
  transferred to another trip or Jterm class.
- Deposits for CVCA-arranged trips will be applied to the total trip cost, with the remaining balance billed through the family's FACTS account.
- Sign-up deposits for trips through our partner travel companies will be applied to additional trip expenses (such as tips, luggage, etc.).

Trips coordinated through our partner travel companies, EF Tours and Joshua Expeditions, require separate
online registration through their respective websites. An additional deposit and trip insurance are required at
the time of registration. The deposit will be applied to the total cost of the trip.

## Puerto Rican Adventure – TRIP (Joshua Expeditions) trip dates January 1-6

Get ready for an immersive adventure in Puerto Rico! Step into history at Old San Juan's iconic city, observe diverse wildlife in El Yunque National Park—the only tropical rainforest in the U.S.—and paddle through glowing waters on a bioluminescent bay kayaking excursion. Discover the wonders of Puerto Rico, sail across crystal-clear waters on a catamaran and snorkeling cruise, and soar through the treetops on a thrilling zip-lining experience. Enjoy a leisurely horseback ride through the lush rainforest, winding your way beneath the canopy until the trees part to reveal a stunning river. Take a moment to pause and soak in the breathtaking scenery. This trip offers the adventurous traveler the perfect opportunity to experience the beauty of Puerto Rico while creating memories for a lifetime.

## Rwanda – TRIP (CVCA)

Non-Refundable Deposit: Deposit \$200, covers tips and baggage fees

Grades: 11, 12 (by invitation only)

Selected students have been invited for a trip to Rwanda to bear witness to the incredible work the Lord is doing in Kigali and Boneza through Arise Rwanda Ministries. On this trip, students will meet the women who create the bags sold by Shya Designs and hear their survival stories, visit the Kivu Hills Academy school that has provided high school education to students in that area for the first time in the region's history. SOMP students will have the opportunity to serve in the brand new hospital that is providing life-saving emergency and basic care for thousands who had to travel up to 80 miles on foot for care previously. In addition, the students will get to enjoy a full-day safari as well as visit the genocide museum, which represents an incredible story of forgiveness.

Note: Students need money for souvenirs.

## STEP Norway - TRIP (CVCA)

Grades: 9, 10, 11, 12

Norway is a beautiful country! Bergen, the second largest city, sits on the western coast and is considered the gateway to the fjords. A highlight of the trip is the "Norway in a Nutshell" tour by train, bus, and boat through the mountains and fjords. The Norway Short Term Exchange Program (STEP) provides the opportunity for home-to-home exchanges between students from Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy and the Danielsen Videregaende School in Bergen, Norway. Students from both schools learn about the customs and culture of the exchange country "from the inside," as they live with a host family. Our students experience first-hand the commonality of faith we enjoy in Christ as we typically attend church and youth group services while we are in Bergen. They also develop a measure of independence as they learn how to deal with a different currency and with people whose native language is not English. Although not a strict requirement, students interested in STEP-Norway should expect to host a Norwegian student from Danielsen School for nine or ten days in the fall. During the trip to Norway, the CVCA students typically stay with the family of the Danielsen student they host in the fall.

## Hiking the Grand Canyon and Sedona – TRIP (CVCA)

Join us for a once-in-a-lifetime adventure to explore one of the most rugged and breathtaking places in the world—the Grand Canyon! As a bonus, we'll spend a day hiking in beautiful Sedona, a sought-after destination in its own right.

This five-day trip features three full days of hiking and two travel days. Each hike will be a day hike, allowing us to return to the comfort of our hotel each night before setting out again the next morning.

This trip is not for the faint of heart. The trails in the Grand Canyon will challenge you physically and mentally like never before. It is both beautiful and brutal. If that sounds overwhelming, this might not be the trip for you—these hikes are rewarding, but not easy.

In addition to the trip cost, participants should budget \$400–\$500 for essential gear (a list will be provided) to ensure both safety and enjoyment. If you went on the Smoky Mountains trip last year, you already have everything you need. Space is limited, so sign up quickly!

## Wrestling - North Florida Training Camp – TRIP (CVCA Athletic)

For Jterm, the wrestling program will travel to the Jacksonville, Florida area for a "North Florida Training Camp". The goal is to strengthen our relationship with the Lord, serve, and strengthen our bond as coaches/athletes and brothers in Christ. To accomplish this, we will spend time in God's word, individually and together as a team, complete a service project with a local church, train with the Camden County wrestling team (ranked 21st nationally), and compete at a local tournament. To cultivate our athletes, will do an individual devotional time in the morning before breakfast and have a team Bible study in the evening after dinner. Our team is partnering with a high-level wrestling team in southern Georgia to train alongside them and use their wrestling facility.

Disc Golf and Digital Media – TRIP (CVCA)

This Jtrm trip combines outdoor recreation with digital marketing insights. Students will learn the basics of disc golf and have the opportunity to play on several local courses, including those at Peaks View Park and the University of Lynchburg. In partnership with Foundation Disc Golf, students will not only enhance their disc golf skills but also gain hands-on experience with the company's marketing strategies. Additionally, they will explore how to effectively position digital media for business marketing, leveraging tools and trends in the field. This blend of physical activity and educational workshops will provide students with a comprehensive and engaging experience.

Students will receive a player pack from Foundation Disc Golf (beginner discs, merch, etc.), but will be responsible for their lunches, dinners, and additional equipment purchases.
