

## 6TH GRADE SUPPLY LIST

To assist middle school students with organizational skills, teachers have been very intentional in indicating certain colors and sizes of binders, as well as other materials. Individual teachers may request additional class supplies.

Student planners will be provided for each 6th grade student.

### General Supplies Needed for ALL Classes:

- 4-pack of multi-colored highlighters (any colors)
- 36 - #2 pencils (mechanical or standard)
- Bright colored pens for grading
- 4 packs of 3x5 cards (lines on one side, blank on the other)
- 3 packs of Expo markers and eraser
- 2 large erasers
- 1 six-inch ruler
- 2 large glue sticks
- 3 packs of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 1 white binder for Bible
- 2 spiral notebooks (90-page, 1-subject)
